Domestic violence refers to one person trying to gain power and maintain control over another in a relationship.

Abusive behavior often seems normal because it is learned from family or other influences. Changing the patterns we are used to takes time and effort, and requires a change in one's thinking. HEAL uses visual and verbal tools to help people account for past and current behavior, and to help change perceptions, thinking, actions and reactions.
